Please complete the following information and submit to the management company no later than 14 business days prior to the event or gathering. If approved, display form at pool 5 business days prior to event.

### Event Rules

1. Setup and cleanup should be done quickly and efficiently, and should include disposal of all trash and rearrangement of the pool area furniture.
2. Gatherings or parties may not exceed 30 persons, may not exceed four hours in duration and may not extend past 9:00 PM.
3. The pool area may not be closed to any non-participant Surfcrest resident.
4. The applicant is responsible for posting of a notice of the party or gathering **5 days** in advance, at the pool area bulletin board.
5. All event attendees will be advised of and will follow all Pool Rules. Pool Rules listed on Page 2.

I agree to advise all of my guests of Surfcrest Rules, and to accept responsibility for damages to the pool area premises that might be caused by my guests. I also understand that I may be assessed a fine by the Association for violation of any Surfcrest rules or other CC&R provisions by my guests.

### POOL RULES

1. Hours: The Pool Area facilities are closed between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. Please be considerate and respectful of nearby residents prior to 7:00 A.M. and after 9:00 P.M.
2. Supervision Required For Children Under Age Fourteen: No child under the age of fourteen shall enter, nor remain within, the Pool Area without the supervision of an adult.
3. Residents and Guests Only: The Surfcrest Pool Area is for the use of residents and their guests only. Day guests must be accompanied by a resident.
4. Pets and Animals Prohibited: No person shall bring any pet or animal into the Pool Area.
5. Littering Prohibited: Residents are responsible for their own, as well as their guests clean up. Trash shall be deposited in appropriate receptacles.
6. Nuisance Prohibited: No person shall disrupt the peaceful use of the Pool Area by others, nor disturb nearby residents, by acting in a rowdy or boisterous manner, by playing loud music, by diving, running, or using profanity.
7. Smoking Prohibited: No person shall smoke within the Pool Area.
8. Prohibited Items: Glass items, bicycles, motorcycles, boogie boards, surf boards, skateboards, and skates are prohibited within the Pool Area.
9. Wetsuits are prohibited in the pool and spa.
10. Limited Number of Guests: No resident shall bring more than 10 guests into the Pool Area, at one time, without prior notification to the Management Company and approval from the Board of Directors. A Pool Party Request Form must be submitted to Management Company for approval 14 working days prior to the event. If approved, the notice must be posted at pool five (5) working days prior to the event. The Management Company / Board of Directors may deny authorization if prior reservations would cause the Pool Area capacity to be exceeded.
11. Responsible Persons: Residents are responsible for their own actions as well as those of their guests.
